- Take your form for your FREE CapTel captioning telephone. Moderate, severe or profound hearing loss will qualify you for this phone that captions what the person is saying. It is no cost to you! The Audiologist will need to sign your form.
- Always make an appointment when your hearing changes or worsens. If your hearing loss progresses to severe-to-profound, never hesitate to visit an ENT to discuss cochlear implants which restore sound.
